In Notts there are 63 approved Shared Life carers https://sharedlivesplus.org.uk/find-your-local-scheme/ There are no qualification requirements to become a carer. The service puts all carers through a 6 month training and assessment programme. The process is like fostering, but service users are over 18 years old. Payments as a carer are dependent upon the needs of the person being cared for. All care takes place in the carers own home – can do days out but the ethos of the scheme is that shared lives is home based. Carers are looked after and supported by 9 co-ordinators across Notts.</p>		
Round Robin	<p>Judy Maher – Citizens Advice Bassetlaw CA are still very much offering energy advice and talks to help Bassetlaw residents to keep their bills low. On average they save people between £200 and £300.</p> <p>Maria Ballantyne Notts CC Reablement Currently undergoing a large work force re-design ahead of a new team development from 1st April 2020. The re-designed service will look for clarity between an individual’s want and their need and will be actively looking to try and stop duplication in the system.</p> <p>Funto Awoleyu Bassetlaw Mind Supportive Listening Service available – face to face, group work, mentoring 12 week programme</p> <p>Jackie McGuinness Connect Manager - Age Uk Funding extended to January 2021 which will then be the 5th year of a 3 + 1 + 1 funding programme.</p> <p>Laura Bennett Working Win Enrolment into the programme ends on 31st October 2019 with clients still being supported through their 9 – 12 month journey. There are some 6 month bank contracts of work available with WW if anyone is looking for a position.</p>		

Gill Harvey Integrated Neighbourhood Teams Rapid response has now transitioned to become the Call for Care service with a 2 hour response. They respond in situations such as where someone has fallen and is waiting for an ambulance, they can respond to ensure the patient is safe and warm until they can be transported to hospital.

Kathryn Baines Community Falls Team Referrals into the team need to come through GPs and there is currently a 6 week wait into the service.

Lauren Price Bassetlaw Mental Health Liaison Team Undertaking urgent mental health assessments. Looking at developments to train general nursing staff in risk assessing, signposting etc. Take referrals in for all age groups.

Cheryl Price Bassetlaw Mental Health Liaison Team Patients can self-refer. Consent is required if another family member makes the referral. The team is available 7.30am – 9pm. Contact number 01159 560 860. The crisis team work with the patient for up to the first 72 hours before signposting into other services.

Colby Andrews Aurora Taking a holistic approach with all patients, undertaking a healthy needs assessment and developing care plans – Individuals can self-refer into Aurora’s services. The Heritage project funding has been agreed and building works will begin in 2020.

Lucy Hull Nottingham Energy Partnership Can help private homeowners and private renters. Help with cavity wall insulation, discounts on water bills, tariff switching. NEP are currently at second stage of a bid to support start up heating installations. From March 2020 NEP will take over the Warm Homes On Prescription contract work from BDC. Judy Maher (CAB) stated that a client of theirs had saved £6k by going through NEP for a boiler installation and cavity wall insulation.

Keisha Pelham RNN Group Works as a skills and employment tutor sourcing work placements for students which include health and social care. Also delivering lessons and getting students to understand the importance of CV, interview skills etc. when entering the job market. Level 2 students have to complete 60 placement hours per year and level 3 students 100 hours.

Siobahn Drake Transform Training Currently running truancy programmes – looking for referrals. Work with young people with learning disability. Break away futures is a 5 session course for 16 years old and over who are unemployed - it supports them to set a plan for the future and to gain confidence and some emotional education – there is no cost for this course and food is provided.

George O’Neill & Trish Charity Just Good friends Run 6 social clubs in Derby and NE Derby’s for adults with LD. In Chesterfield and Belper they take over night clubs one a month and run events for attendees. Looking for volunteers and new members and want to expand into Bassetlaw.

Julie Harper DWP Disability Work Coach for Bassetlaw – coaches other work colleagues and works in partnership across the District.

Ben Eckersley Bassetlaw Integrated care Partnership Great to hear the Aurora building news. Purpose of the ICP to look specifically at Bassetlaw area, bringing people together to improve the lives of partners. The “What Next” careers event was spearheaded by the ICP workforce work stream – fantastic attendance from schools, organisations and employees. Now a work stream looking at tackling childhood

	<p>obesity and also a cancer work stream. Cancer themes: Prevention, Early Identification, Treatment timely and effective, Long term consequences and living beyond diagnosis. Transport work is looking at improving connections around the district – in mid Sept there was a successful transport summit – working through the actions from this. Travel between Worksop and Doncs hospital – bus services came together to look at improving routes for both shift workers and patients alike. Encouraging people to use cycles and be more active. Miles in May will take place again in 2020.</p> <p>Tracey Parr Re-Engage Now managing the community Christmas website logging all activities and social events.</p> <p>Kerry Hessey SJW Wright Care Awarded as Outstanding by the CQC (Care Quality Commission). Work with both private and social funded patients. Includes end of life care, dementia, mobility, help with shopping etc.</p>
