Our Aim

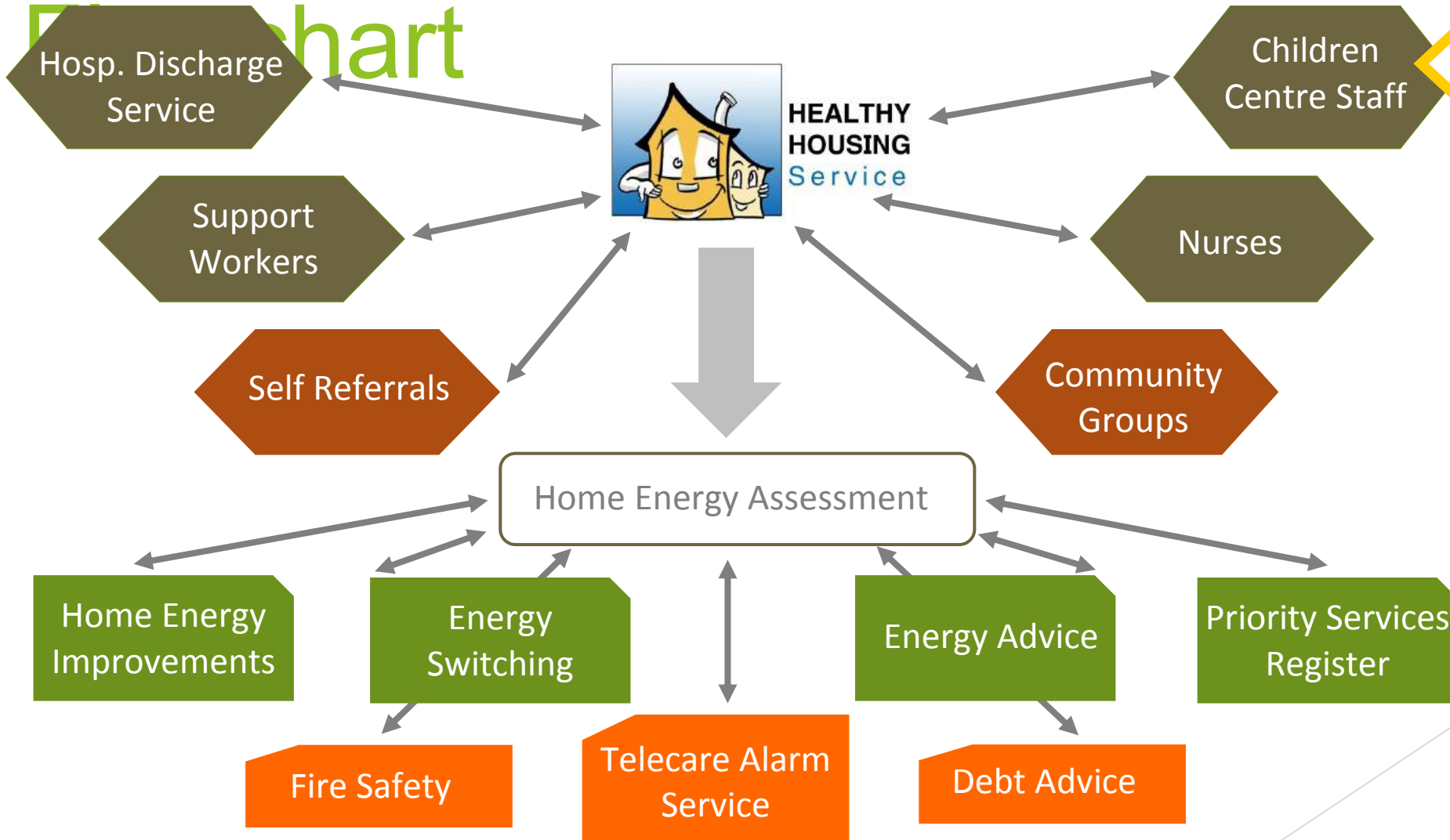
To tackle FUEL POVERTY by providing affordable warmth solutions to the most deprived PRIVATE SECTOR households in Nottinghamshire in order to achieve:

- ▶ 18 year partnership with Public Health
