The aim of the service is to link people with their local communities, to find solutions that are personal to your needs, and provide support to help you maintain a healthy and independent life.

HOW DO I ACCESS THE SERVICE?

If you think you could benefit from Connect, you can call us on 0115 844 3541 or email NCHABassetlawConnect@ncha.org.uk to arrange a free home visit.

Alternatively, you can be referred to us via any other support agency who recognises that you may need our help.

HOW WILL YOU SUPPORT ME?

We will visit you within the first week of receiving your enquiry to talk to you about how you're feeling, and how you'd like your life to improve. We recognise that everyone is different and will tailor the support to your individual needs.

We will work with you to find solutions that take into account your needs and requirements, while considering your existing skills that may be a platform for you to learn new ways to do things.

One of our main aims will be to work with you, to build connections with people and organisations around you who may be able to better support you to live independently.

Following this, we may continue to support you face to face for up to 12 weeks.
