Linking physical and mental wellbeing through things such as exercise groups. Will use existing services. - Offer a lifetime membership to coffee morning on the last Friday of the month where there is no charge. For people who don't fit services or have reached the end of their treatment. - Deliver training to companies in the area- paid for service which helps fund the centre in Worksop. - Counselling is available by self-referral for 18+ years. 8 session pp which can be extended up to 20 if necessary. £12.50 for unemployed, £20 for employed. Hope to do couples counselling in the future. - Community Garden behind nursing home on Gateford Road is open to all, all of the time. MIND member of staff is there Thursday's 10-12.
