SYREC covers South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw ICS region. Reporting to LWAB

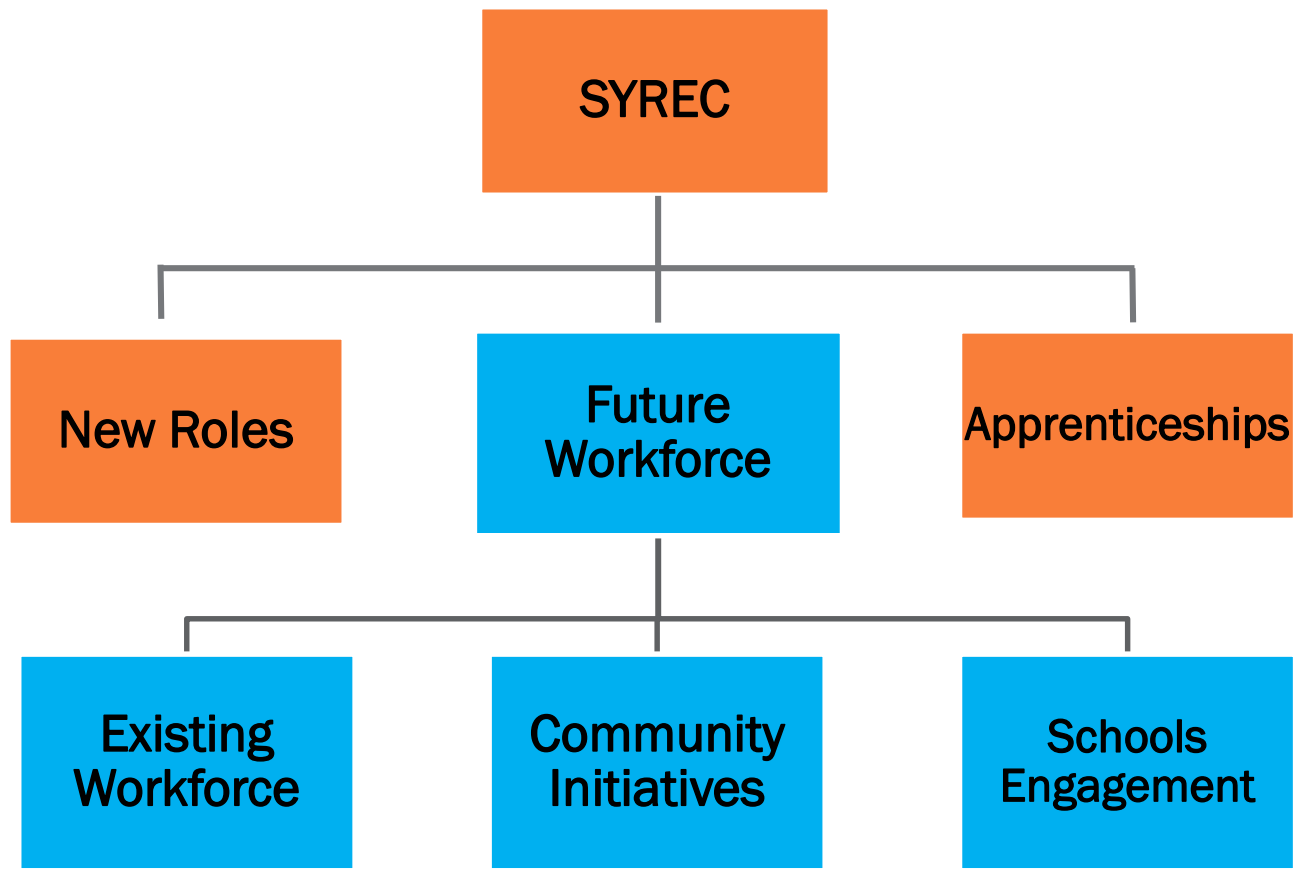
We are here to ...

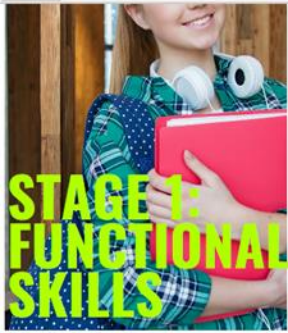
We work with....

Unlock local potential to supply the very best people to health and social care jobs

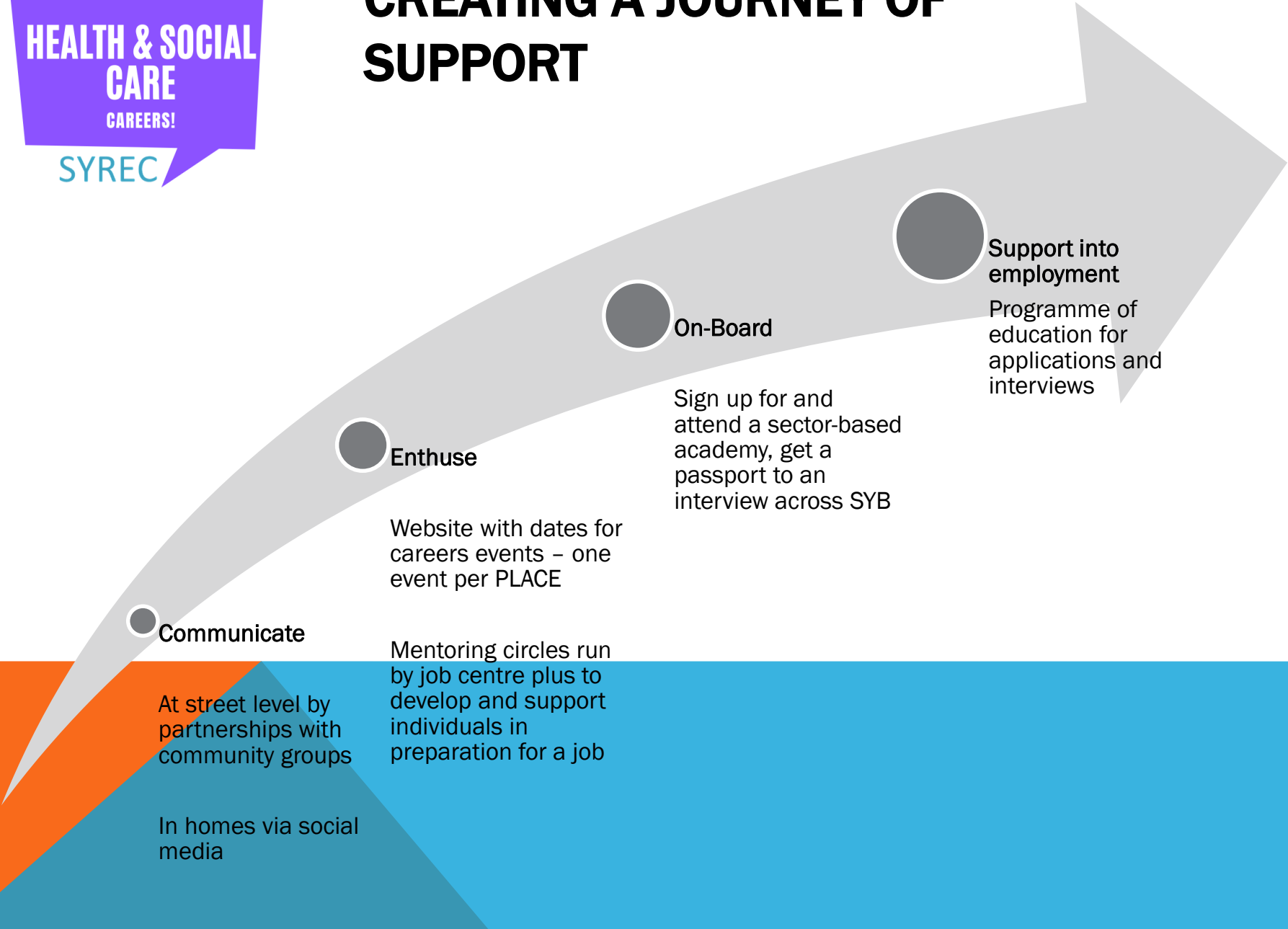
