## **Funding to Support Charities Across GB and Ireland**

Grants of between £1,000 and £10,000 are available for charities and not-for-profit organisations to support charitable projects in communities across Great Britain and Ireland.

Funding is available for projects in the following areas:

- **Community Development**
- **Peace and Reconciliation**
- **Education**
- **Arts and Culture**

There is two staged application process. The first step requires applicants to submit a letter of enquiry outlining the details of the proposed project.

**Letters of Enquiry for 2021 will be accepted until 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2021 (23:00).**

## **TechX Clean Energy Accelerator Funding**

The TechX Clean Energy Accelerator is an intensive 15-week full-time programme for up to 12 innovative clean energy start-ups with clear potential to significantly accelerate the transition to an affordable net zero energy industry.

Companies chosen for the accelerator will receive a £100,000 grant and expert help from a range of delivery partners and mentors, among other benefits.

# Applications Invited for Animal Welfare and Veterinary Research Projects

Petplan Charitable Trust offers grants to registered charities and scientific institutions to support advances in veterinary science and the work of organisations committed to the health and wellbeing of animals.

There are two categories of funding:

- Welfare grants between £5,000 and £25,000 for the direct benefit of species supported by the Trust (ie, dogs, cats, horses, and rabbits).
- Scientific grants consisting of:
  - Initial Scientific grants over £10,000 for veterinary medicine research projects lasting up to three years.
  - Pump Primer/Pilot grants up to £10,000 lasting no more than one year for graduates embarking on a research career.

Eligible activities include:

- Rescue and rehoming.
- Animal housing maintenance and repairs.
- Neutering and other veterinary services.
- Clinical research.
- Animal welfare education projects.

The application deadlines are: **26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 for Initial Scientific grants; 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 for Welfare Grants; and 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 for Pump/Pilot grants.**
