The Venue:

The event provides an opportunity to have an informal tour of Worksop's new £3.5m state-of-the art education hub. The Bridge Skills Hub forms part of our response to provide local, employer lead higher skills. The building features an 80 seat auditorium, six classrooms, an IT suite and various rooms that can be reconfigured and turned into medical settings, such as hospital wards, to enable health students to gain practical experience that mirror real life settings.

It is hoped the building will help provide new learning opportunities for local people and bridge the skills gap while also helping to boost footfall in the town. Creation of The Bridge has been supported by the D2N2 LEP with funding of £3.5million from their allocation of the Government's Getting Building Fund.





Where to find us:

The Bridge is easily accessible by bus and train but for those that want to drive there a number of pay and display car parks a short walk away. When you arrive please access the building at the main entrance located on Bridge Place (shown in image below). You will be welcomed by the staff at The Bridge.

The closest pay and display car park is located on Gateford Road (S80 1EB), Memorial Avenue (S80 2BP) and the Priory Centre (S80 1RX) – all no more than a 2 minute walk away.
