# As a result of a fall, the patient needed further support to aid recovery.

### What happened

After having a fall, a patient realised that not only did she need help and support with her day to day life as a result of her injuries, it was also apparent that she needed additional support in other areas of her life.

They were referred in to BCVS for support with claiming benefits, accessing physical activity and exploring the possibility of community transport schemes.
