Tender or contract specific questions:

What are fair / reasonable questions for funders to ask? Pros and cons of standardised questions across multiple funders?

- A. Beneficiaries / service users Who do you serve, geographically and communities of interest?
- B. **Experience** What experience does your organisation have?
- C. **Evidence of need** What primary evidence of need do you have? (ie where you have conducted the research yourself)

 What secondary evidence of need do you have (eg Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) data, wider health data etc)?
- D. Codesign How have service users or the target community been involved in design and delivery of the support or service proposed?
- E. Service or Support Model What is your proposed model / offer?
- F. Capacity How many FTE staff do you employ? How many volunteers do you currently work with? How many trustees?
- G. **Demographics** What is the profile of your staff / volunteers / service users? Do you monitor this? What do you do with the data?
- H. Partnership experience What is your experience of funded partnership working?
- I. Contract compliance What is your experience of reporting to funders?
- J. **Contract performance** Have there been any historical contract performance issues in your organisation leading to under performance?
- K. Strategic Fit What is the fit with national, regional and local context of the proposed service or project?
