Limestone House, Creswell





Limestone House provides a much needed support and social facility in the centre of Crewsell and due to various circumstances in September 2021, several Trustees resigned and the organisation was at risk of closure.



BCVS has been a crucial partner in helping Limestone House, a charity based in the Bolsover district, to recruit and retain new trustees with the right skills to support the charity's mission. BCVS offered guidance and support throughout the recruitment process, helping Limestone House to identify and attract candidates with the right skills and experience. Additionally, BCVS has suggested relevant training to the charity's existing trustees, to provide opportunities that have helped them better understand their roles and responsibilities. Finally, BCVS has also helped Limestone House to ensure that its infrastructure is robust enough to support the needs of the local community, providing advice on governance, finance, and other operational matters to ensure that the charity can continue to deliver its services effectively.
