

But you promised to remain with us till the end of time,


And to send us the Holy Spirit.

St Paul's Food Hub is not part of the Food Bank and is open to all the community. The food available each week has either been donated to the local community hubs by local supermarkets or purchased from FareShare. We have no idea from one week to the next what foods will be available and it is always a great surprise!

The purpose of community food hubs is to cut down on the amount of food wasted, which ends up in landfill, and to redistribute that food at an affordable price

The St Paul's food hub team are keen to make the hub an inviting and informative experience. We are personally inviting those who come to arrive earlier and sit and chat with us and other members of the community while enjoying a cuppa and biscuit. A children's corner is also set up.

Free, informal concerts on Thursdays from 12 - 12.35 in Worksop Priory church


No tickets; just arrive; bring lunch if you like.

June 1st: Debbie Dalgliesh, Violin with Rosemary Field, piano






National Pilgrimage to Walsingham


