POV has also linked us with like-minded organisations, which can only prove beneficial for the future. One young person from Rhubarb even volunteered to work with our tutor in Worksop to provide art sessions for our young people, and this was a resounding success for all.

Key outcomes and impact:

1. Having young people focusing on art, video creation and the staging of an event provides valuable development for employability and life skills, not least their self-confidence.
2. Staging the event was a rewarding experience for all, allowing the young people of POV to showcase the product of their efforts and enjoy how others appreciated their work.
3. Having the opportunity to develop relationships with other organisations, such as Rhubarb Farm, Centreplace and Mansfield CVS, has been beneficial for all of the young people involved, and hopefully in the future, will be beneficial for the communities of which they are a part.
